

Dear colleagues,

We invite your students to take part in the Global HackAtom National Stage in Serbia. This event is organized by the National Research Nuclear University MEPhI together with the University of Belgrade and the Rosatom State Corporation.

Global HackAtom is an international competition where students solve real practical problems in the nuclear field. Since 2021, it has been held in more than 20 countries and has involved over 1,300 students from around the world. The project supports international cooperation and encourages student interest in science, engineering, and clean energy.

National stages take place over two days. On the first day, a partner university team delivers expert lectures and presents a case study assignment to student teams. The teams then have 24 hours to develop their solutions. On the second day, teams defend their projects before an expert jury composed of representatives from Rosatom, Russian universities, and partner organizations.

The National Stage in Serbia will take place on May 26–27. The registration deadline is May 22.

The winning team will have a chance to take part in the Global HackAtom Grand Final. Teams from about 15 countries will compete there. The final will be held during the International Youth Festival in Yekaterinburg (September 11–17, 2026).
